

POLICY NUMBER: 9412 Player Discipline

ISSUED : 4/26/94 **REVISED :** 6/8/98

PURPOSE:

This policy is to serve as an outline for players' manner while participating and playing for St. Jane Soccer Association. While playing on the field, or in attendance at a practice, the attitude of the participant remains the business of the St. Jane Soccer Association. The Board reserves the right to take any action it feels is necessary to prevent discipline problems, even if it means expelling the child from further play or suspending the player for a required time period.

BACKGROUND:

1. On a day-to-day basis player discipline will be the right and responsibility of the coach.
2. Prior to the start of the season, coaches shall distribute team rules to players and parents outlining the do's and don'ts expected from players and parents. Coaches are permitted to develop their team's rules.
3. A coach may not suspend or remove a player from their roster without the consent of the Board. Suspensions or expulsions must be requested via the grievance form.
4. Items which constitute disciplinary action include: insubordination, obscene language, racial slurs and fighting.
