At the top of your essay, please include the question you choose from below.

Essay Question 1:

Sportsmanship is an important factor in all sports. What experience have you had in AAYSL which have taught you about the value of good sportsmanship? How do you feel these lessons may help you as an adult, to be more successful in you academic pursuits, career and family life?

Essay Question 2:

As you prepare for a career, what important values and principles do you take with you as a result of your participation in the AAYSL? What personal strengths have you gained and would like to pass on to younger players, if you had the opportunity?
